Equipment & materials list

Materials are not included in the course fee. All the materials and equipment you will need are listed below.

- Landscape reference photo/s (a black & white version is useful)
- Medium weight cartridge paper for exercises
- Heavyweight watercolour paper (300gsm or heavier) – you may prefer to work on canvas or board
- Acrylic paints in basic colours:
 - Process Cyan
 - Process Magenta
 - Process Yellow
 - Black
 - White

(Karen recommends Daler Rowney System 3 but feel free to use any you have)

- Optional: Fine tip Posca pens or similar in cream or white
- Optional: Oil pastels
- Brushes – whatever you have (including scraggy old brushes!) include a flat brush if you can
- Sponges
- Palette knife if you have one
- Mixing palette / plate (I will show you how to make a cheap ‘stay-wet’ palette)
- Kitchen roll, water pots, apron or old shirt (essential – acrylics are waterproof when dry!)
