



Equipment & materials list

Materials are not included in the course fee. All the materials and equipment you will need are listed below.

- Watercolour paper or mixed media paper or heavy cartridge (approx. 200gsm)
- Calico, if you want to print on fabric (acrylic paint is needed for fabric printing – watercolour will bleed too much)
- Scissors & craft knife
- Lino-cutting tools if you have them (not essential)
- Tracing paper or greaseproof paper
- Acrylic paints or watercolours (tube watercolours work best) – whatever you have – if buying specially just buy primary colours and white (buy white gouache if using watercolours)
- Optional: Aquapasto medium if using watercolours or rice paste to thicken them (tutor will provide a recipe for making rice paste or it can be purchased from handprinted.co.uk)
- Mixing palette /old plate, brushes (whatever you have)
- Kitchen roll, water pot, Kitchen sponge
- Vegetables – carrots, okra (not essential), potato
- Kids craft foam (self-adhesive if possible or you will need double-sided tape) & small piece of cardboard
- Polystyrene (food packaging works well)
- Large pencil eraser such as Helix
