Equipment & Materials List

Sketchbooks/loose papers

- White, some heavier watercolour paper/card too for our ink & water backgrounds
- A selection of coloured toned papers, especially kraft and grey, one or two brighter ones as well

Coloured inks for pre-prepared backgrounds

- White gouache
- Bring what you have a mix of different kinds and makes is best so that they react better with one another.

Pat loves these and will be demonstrating with them:

- De Atramentis Fog grey
- o Sennelier Carmine, sky blue
- Black indian ink
- o Private Reserve Buttercup Yellow
- Alcohol inks
- o Spritzer inks are fun too but not essential!

Back-up basics (Mostly for use in Class 2!)

- Large table space to tape down 5 or 6 sheets of heavy watercolour paper
- Table covering
- 3 or 4 smallish water containers
 - A larger one for clean water
 - A big, tall one for dirty brushes
- Table salt



- Masking tape & scissors
- Stripey Washi tape
- Steel palette knife
- Paper towels
- Brushes:
 - large soft (for transferring water)
 - rigger (for pulling lines of colour out of coloured pools)
 - several smaller brushes for plopping different colours into water
 (Pat loves dagger and sword brushes)

DRAWING TOOLS

- Posca Bullet Tip acrylic paint pens in sky blue, aqua green, bright red OR
 Hobbycraft's SHORE & MARSH brand 8 pack (bright) acrylic paint pens
- Fountain pen and black ink (medium nib more versatile. Fudes give a lovely variety of line)
- Pentel brush sign pen SES115C (flexible plastic nib, rather like a Fude..
 Pat will be demo-ing with a black and bright pink)
- Staedtler Mars Lumograph 8B (matte, very black. Make sure you buy the Black bodied one, not the green!)
- Mitsubishi broad white signo uniball pen
- Coloured pencils:
 - Pat's favourites are Holbein Artists' pencils and Caran D'Ache
 Supracolor watercolour pencils.
 - You will need white, cream, sky blue, aqua, ochre, royal blue, and lime green (available individually from Jackson's Arts online)

EXTRAS (good to have but not essential):

- Peter Pauper watercolor crayons
- Peter Pauper Bible Highlighters
